Working with the Relational Unconscious in the Therapeutic Process

In this workshop Marsha and Maria will explore the concept of the 'analytic third'; the concept of a shared relational unconscious process between therapist and client. They will enable participants to explore how enactment in the therapeutic process may be related to impasse in the work and look for ways forward in these cases.

Professor Maria Gilbert is joint head of the Integrative Department at Metanoia Institute with Vanja Orlans. She has for twelve years been involved in the integrative psychotherapy training at Metanoia and has recently co-authored a book with Ken Evans entitled: *An Introduction to Integrative Psychotherapy*.

Marsha Nodelman is a founder member and has been head of training at the London Ass. of Primal Psychotherapists. She is a training therapist and supervisor and has twenty years of clinical experience; in addition to clinical work she teaches. She is on the steering committee for the UK grouping of the International Ass. of Relational Psychoanalysis and Psychotherapy (IARPP).
